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**Greenwood Township Annual Town Meeting**

The 2010 Annual Township meeting was called to order at 7:00p.m. on April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2010 by Supervisor Barb Klasen, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Nominations for moderator were called for with Christopher Dahm nominating Craig Pfannkuche and Colleen Dumais seconding. As there were no other nominations, vote was taken on Craig Pfannkuche as moderator and it was unanimous. After signing the Oath of Moderator, Craig Pfannkuche asked for a reading of the minutes of the 2009 Annual Township meeting by Clerk Kendra Rishling. On motion by Karen Roth and a second by Christopher Dahm the reading of the minutes from April 14<sup>th</sup>, 2009 was waived and unanimously approved as written.

**Approval of Financial Reports:**

The financial report for the Road & Bridge Money Market Account were read by the Township Clerk Kendra Rishling. Christopher Dahm motioned to approve the numbers for the Money Market Account Road & Bridge. Karen Swencki seconded. Motion approved.

The financial reports for the Permanent Road Fund were read by the Township Clerk Kendra Rishling. Tim Stefaniak motioned to approve the Permanent Road Fund; Christopher Dahm seconded. Motion approved.

The financial reports for the Building & Equipment Fund were read by the Township Clerk Kendra Rishling. Tim Stefaniak motioned to approve the Building & Equipment Fund; Karin Swencki seconded. Motion approved.

The financial reports for the Insurance Fund were read by the Township Clerk Kendra Rishling. Ron Caprio motioned to approve the Insurance Fund; Gary Aavang seconded. Motion approved.

Motion to approve waiving the reading of the numbers by the Township Clerk Kendra Rishling by Tim Stefaniak. Seconded by Gary Aavang. Motion Approved.

The financial reports for the Town Fund Money Market Account was presented by the Township Clerk Kendra Rishling. Christopher Dahm motioned to approve; Gary Aavang seconded. Motion Approved.

Township Clerk Kendra Rishling presented the financial report for the Town Fund Checking Account. Gary Aavang motioned to approve; Charles Beard seconded. Motion approved.

Township Clerk Kendra Rishling presented the General Assistance Fund Checking Account. Motion to approve the General Assistance Fund Checking Account by Charles Beard; seconded by Karin Swencki. Motion approved.

Motion to approve a one-time transfer of funds from the Insurance Fund back to the Road and Bridge by Karin Swencki and seconded by Gary Aavang. Unanimously, all said aye and motion carried.

### **Questions/Comments:**

Craig Pfannkuche asked Highway Commissioner Don Goad if there was a contract between the Greenwood Township and the Village of Greenwood for maintaining roads for snow removal. Don Goad stated that there was not an official agreement but that there is a courtesy that Greenwood assisted in snow removal on roads that intersected Township roads. He also stated that they were looking at a contract in the future.

Craig Pfannkuche asked Highway Commissioner Don Goad about where the woodchips go when trees are trimmed. Highway Commissioner Don Goad stated that he had thought about putting a pile that the Township people could take from if they needed.

Craig Pfannkuche asked the Supervisor Barb Klasen if there were any plans to put a transportation service in the Township for Senior. Supervisor Barb Klasen said she was looking into a program for a senior van and possibly using public transportation associated with Pace as well.

Craig Pfannkuche asked Supervisor Barb Klasen if there was an increase in available housing for people who are in need from the Housing Authority. Supervisor Barb Klasen stated that there had not been an increase in the Township at this time.

Charles Beard motioned to set the next annual meeting for the second Tuesday in April at 7:30 p.m.; Colleen Dumais seconded. Ron Caprio stated that he would like to see the meeting at 7:30 to accommodate the farmers and the people getting off work. Motion passed.

Colleen Dumais motioned to adjourn the meeting at 8:25 p.m.; Christopher Dahm seconded. Motion approved and meeting adjourned.
