Greenwood Township Board of Trustees
Monthly Meeting Minutes

January 24th, 2011

Supervisor Barbara Klasen called the monthly meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees to order at 7:40 pm followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Board Members Present: Trustee Christopher Dahm, and Trustee Charles Beard .

Other Members Present: Supervisor Barb Klasen , Highway, Commissioner Don Goad, and Clerk Kendra Rishling.

Approval of Meeting Minutes: Christopher Dahm motioned and seconded by Charles Beard to approve the monthly meeting minutes for December 20th , 2010 as amended.

Approval of Township and Road District Bills: Motion to approve the Township and Road District Bills by Christopher Dahm and seconded by Charles Beard. By roll call vote, all in favor said aye. Motion Carried.

Assessor's Report: Not present.

New Business: Board presented a Notice of Conditional Use on the property with pin number 08-22-300-012 which is located approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile west of the intersection of Greenwood Road and Charles Road. This property is currently zoned A-1 agriculture. The petitioner, Blue Lotus Buddhist temple 520 Devonshire Lane #8 Crystal Lake, Illinois 60014, is currently the owner of the property. The request was submitted on January 18th, 2010 to the McHenry County Zoning Board of Appeals. The request was presented to the Board for review. The Greenwood Township Board voiced concern on this project due to lack of information on future plans for the site including traffic flow in and out of the site.

The Board then discussed meeting times and dates for the year 2011. The Board agreed that the meetings should continue on the third Monday of each month at 7:30pm.
